

JEFF EGLASH

FOR POLICE COMMISSIONER

Jeff Eglash has served on the Weston Police Commission since December 2008. He previously served on Weston's Board of Ethics. Jeff is an attorney who has spent most of his legal career working with law enforcement and in the criminal justice system.

Before moving to Weston four years ago, Jeff served as the Inspector General for the Los Angeles Police Department. In that job Jeff was responsible for providing civilian oversight of the LAPD, working to make sure that all members of the department acted with integrity, professionalism, and within the bounds of the law and the department's policies and procedures. During Jeff's tenure, the LAPD made great strides in improving its standing in the community and becoming a model police department that was responsive to and reflected the values of the communities it served.

Before working with the LAPD, Jeff was an Assistant United States Attorney for the U.S. Department of Justice in Los Angeles. As a federal prosecutor, Jeff served as Chief of the Public Corruption & Government Fraud Section. Jeff's section brought cases involving health care fraud, environmental crimes, defense contractor fraud, and political corruption. Jeff successfully prosecuted one of the largest police corruption cases in California history, involving numerous corrupt members of the Los Angeles Sheriffs Department, who were caught skimming cash seized during drug raids. Jeff has also worked as a litigation partner at the law firm Howrey & Simon, and earlier as a Deputy District Attorney in Los Angeles. Jeff went to college and law school at the University of California, Berkeley.

Jeff hopes to continue serving Weston through his work with the Weston Police Department. In his time so far on the Commission, Jeff has brought his background and experience as a lawyer, prosecutor, and police oversight-specialist to bear on police department policies and procedures. Jeff wants to support and enhance our Department's reputation as one of Connecticut's finest, most professional, and best trained police departments.

Jeff currently works as an attorney for General Electric in Fairfield, where he handles litigation, investigations, and compliance. His wife, Dr. Karen Sitney, is a scientist at Boehringer-Ingelheim. They have two sons: Elliott, age 14, is in 9th grade at Weston H.S. and Ben, who is 10, is in 5th grade at Weston Intermediate.
