Thank you for your letter dated March 18, 2008, notifying the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) of the South Western Regional Planning Agency's (SWRPA) proposed addenda updates to the Regional Plan of Conservation & Development, 2006-2015. I understand that SWRPA will be conducting two public hearings on June 17, 2008, as part of the formal Regional Plan update process.

I have reviewed the proposed addenda which have been individually approved by SWRPA. The addenda include the Long Range Transportation Plan: 2007-2035, the Regional Housing Needs and Assessment, and the 2007 South Western Region Open Space Inventory, all of which will enhance the Regional Plan that was adopted on February 6, 2006.

Therefore, OPM hereby determines, in accordance with Section 8-35a(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, that the Regional Plan as updated to include the proposed addenda is not inconsistent with the Conservation and Development Policies Plan for Connecticut, 2005-2010.

Upon its adoption by the SWRPA Board, the revised plan will serve as an effective guide to SWRPA member municipalities when they update their own plans of conservation and development.
