WHO

LACOMBE, LOUISIANA

- Situated on the north shore of Lake Ponchartrain in St Tammany Parish, directly in the path of Katrina and the subsequent flooding.

- Similar to Weston in size, Lacombe was a community of approximately 10,000 before Katrina

- Approximately 2,200 school age children attending four schools



- One of the poorest communities in the Parish

- 500 families left homeless after the hurricanes - only slowly rebuilding



- Families need the basic household essentials to start over again

THE TOWN TO TOWN PARTNERSHIP

- The Weston Town to Town Partnership, under the leadership of a 7 member Select Committee, is coordinating a town wide effort to address the community of Lacombe's most critical needs
- Established in October, 2005 by the Board of Selectman to select a Sister City and coordinate ongoing efforts
- Facilitate support for the town's short term needs for recovery and build a mutually beneficial long term relationship
- Has already coordinated efforts of over 100 Westonites to help families, children, schools, fire and police services, etc through the donation of funds and services
